# RIDERS OF GRACE

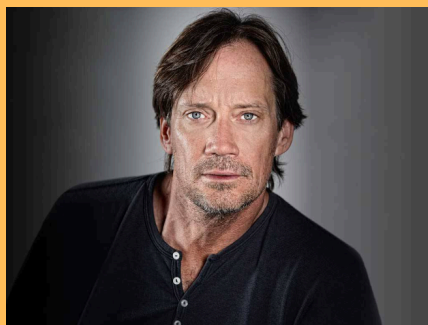
## A FILM PROJECT WITH CONVICTION

An international action film project titled “Riders of Grace” is currently in development — a story that goes where it hurts: into the realities of **human trafficking, abuse of power, and moral cowardice**.

The **Jesus Bikers**® are not a side element, but a core part of the story.

*Riders of Grace* tells of **faith that refuses to stay silent**, of men who refuse to look away — and of the decision to stand up when others profit. It is a film about **justice on the streets**, about **discipline, sacrifice, and spiritual strength** — told through **action, martial arts, and authentic biker culture** for an international audience.

**Cast** (Letters of Intent):



- **Kevin Sorbo** stars in the lead role — known from *God’s Not Dead* and *Let There Be Light*.
- **Matthias Hues**, international actor and martial artist (*Dark Angel / I Come in Peace, Kickboxer II*), plays the second lead: **the leader of the Jesus Bikers** — a character who unites physical power with spiritual clarity.

**Director:** **Mike Elliott** is an experienced director and producer with over **70 feature films** to his credit, known for commercially successful, audience-driven films and franchise productions. His strengths lie in efficient filmmaking, clear target-audience focus, and solid storytelling for international markets.

**Producer:** Executive Producer is **Chris Peschken**, an internationally experienced filmmaker with decades of work in the U.S. and Europe.

The film is scheduled to be shot on original locations in **Germany in May 2026, in English**.

The title song "Ride Me Home" (lyrics by Chris Peschken) will be performed & produced by **Cat Lion**, who will also appear in the film. The songs are produced in Nashville, musically carrying themes of homecoming, hope, and redemption.



*Riders of Grace* is faith-inspired — but uncompromising.
